

DATA PROTECTION DECLARATION

Declaration on the information obligation according to GDPR

The protection of your personal data is particularly important for us. Thus we process your data exclusively on the basis of legal regulations. In this data protection information we inform you about the most important aspects of data processing concerning our website.

Contact with us

If you contact us by using the form on the website or via email, your details from the request form, including the contact details you provided there, will be stored by us for processing the request and any follow-up questions for the duration of twelve months. This data is not forwarded without your approval. We cannot process your inquiries without this data.

Storage of data

In addition, the following data is also stored with us for the purpose of contract execution: name of your company, address of your company, your first name, your last name, your email address, your phone number.

We process your personal data (name of your company, address of your company, your first name, your last name, your email address, your telephone number), as far as necessary, for the duration of the entire business relationship (from initiation, processing to termination of a contract) as well as in accordance with the statutory storage and documentation obligations, which among others arise from company and financial laws and regulations as well as until the end of a possible legal dispute, ongoing warranty and guarantee periods etc. The data processing is based on statutory provisions and on Art. 6 Para 1 a (consent) and/or b (required for contract fulfillment) of the GDPR.

Order processing

For operating our website we hire providers, software service providers, agencies etc., who can have access to your personal data in the course of their activities, if they need the data to fulfill their respective performance. These have committed themselves to comply with the applicable data protection regulations. Order processing contracts were concluded in accordance with Art. 28 GDPR. Server log files

The provider of the websites automatically collects and stores information in so-called server log files, which your browser automatically transmits to us. These are:

- browser type and version
- used operating system

- referrer URL
- host name of the accessing computer
- time of the server request
- IP address

There will be no merge with other data sources. The basis for data processing is Art. 6 Para. 1 f GDPR, which allows processing of data for the execution of a contract or pre-contractual measures.

Cookies

Our website uses so-called cookies. These are small text files that are stored on your device using the browser. They do no harm.

We use cookies to make our offer user-friendly. Some cookies are stored on your device until they are deleted. They allow us to recognize your browser the next time you are visiting our website.

If you do not want this, you can set up your browser to inform you about the setting of cookies and you can allow this only in individual cases.

Deactivating cookies may limit the functionality of our website.

Web analytics

This website uses Google (Universal) Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google Inc. (www.google.com). Google (Universal) Analytics uses methods that allow you to analyze the use of the website, such as so-called "cookies", text files that are stored on your computer. The generated information about your use of this website is usually transmitted to a Google server in the USA and stored there. By activating IP anonymization on this website, the IP address will be shortened prior to transmission within the member states of the European Union or in other contracting states of the Agreement on the European Economic Area.
